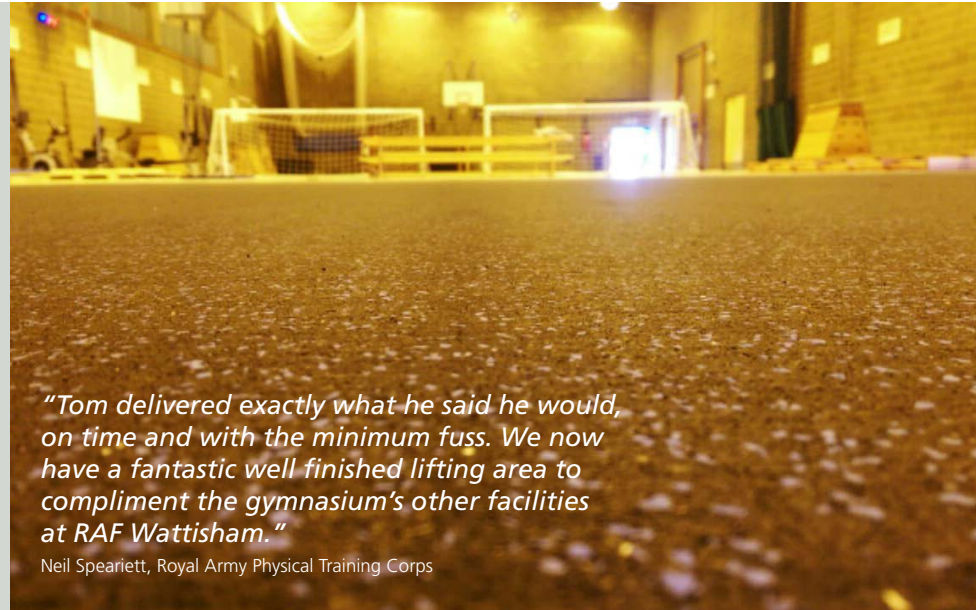


RAF Wattisham, Suffolk

Rubber indoor sports surfacing

RAF Wattisham is a former Royal Air Force station located in East Anglia, just outside the village of Wattisham in Suffolk.

Bradleys Surfacing Systems were contracted to convert an existing wooden sports floor into a rubber gym floor, suitable for weight training. The install involved taking up the existing timber floor, installing 50mm of liquid screed concrete and 40mm of PVP rubber surfacing.

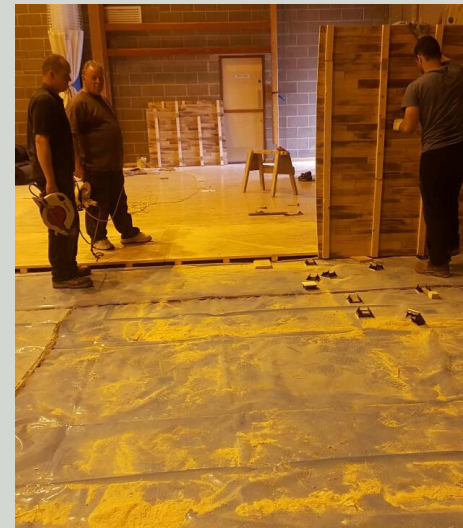
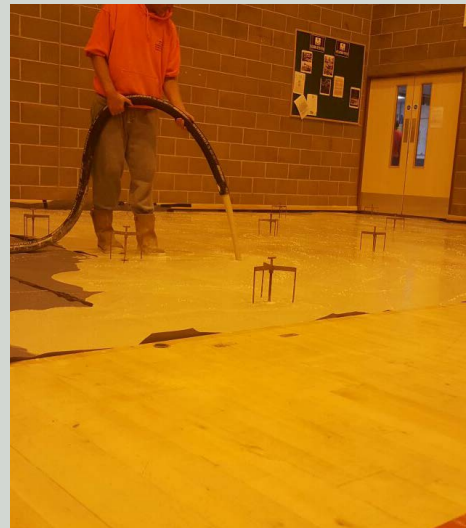
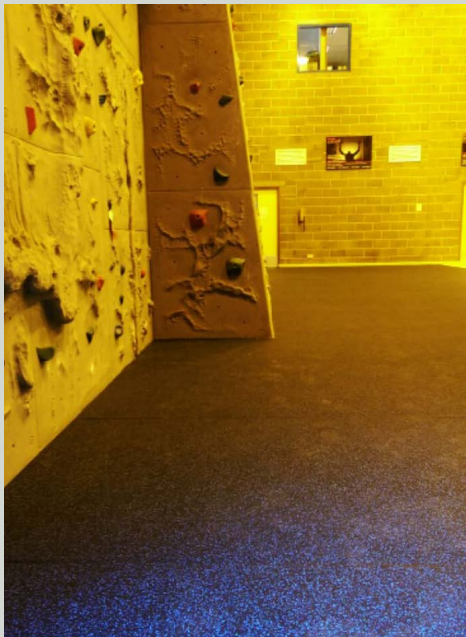
