

# Barnett Wood Infant School, Ashtead

## Rubber cycle track Outdoor wet-pour playground surfacing

The BBC released a report in 2015 about a 'daily mile' scheme that a school in Scotland had put in place to encourage pupils to walk or run for a mile every day as way of improving fitness and reducing childhood obesity.

Following the report, Headteacher of Barnett Wood Infant School, Mrs Penny contacted Bradleys Surfacing Systems to install a new outdoor cycle track at their facility. The cycle track was laid with green wet-pour surfacing to minimise injury risk for children, as well as for shock absorbency and slip resistance. The edging was complete with 2,500 blocks and 11.5 cubic meters of concrete.
