

Reddish Hall School, Stockport

Full multi-use games area (MUGA) construction

Reddish Hall School in Stockport provides education for children with complex educational needs, communication difficulties and challenging behaviour. The school, which has been named 'outstanding' by Ofsted, focuses on children with individual needs deemed too complex to be addressed within a mainstream setting.

With the school relatively new, having only opened in 2015, Bradleys Surfacing Systems were brought in to carry out a full construction of a MUGA for football, netball, hockey and tennis. The team did a full excavation of the area, carried out a sub-base construction and installed new PPC edging. A 3m high rebound fence system and porous macadam surfacing was also installed. Playrite's Matchplay2 on a Matchpad shock pad was chosen as the surfacing, which is ideal for the school as it's low maintenance, suitable for all weather usage and has high performance and durability.
