Conversion of unused tennis courts into a state-of-the-art 3G surface

In 2015, Bradleys installed a Multi-Use Games Area at Manor Farm Community Association and returned to the facility a few years later to carry out their largest contract to date.

The charity had benefited from over £235,000 worth of funding to dramatically improve the landscape of the former derelict facility and appointed Bradleys as the main contractor to convert four old unused tennis courts into a flood-lit state-of-the-art 3G facility for football use.

The new sports facility will be used extensively by a variety of local football clubs, including children of all ages and sexes, as well as the ever increasingly popular walking football for the die-hard Bobby Charlton's of Walsall.
