Perryfields PRU

Bradleys carried out the refurbishment of an existing play area at Perryfields PRU in Worcester. With the plan to enhance the schools provision for sports and play, Bradleys converted an existing tarmac base into a top level multi-year surface. The project involved the team installing new PCC edging, drilling the base for drainage and installing a 10mm in-situ rubber shock pad into an area of 237m² with TigerTurf Evo Excel synthetic turf. The surrounds were excavated and the team laid a 40mm rubber mulch surface on the court surrounds to maintain a clean environment.



Smart Start Day Nursery

Smart Start Day Nursery was keen to install some new playground surfacing for their children to play on, so enlisted the help of Bradleys Surfacing Systems to supply and install this for them. The team used TigerTurf Finesse Deluxe synthetic turf, which not only looks great, but can be easily maintained too. An APE TeK16mm foam shock pad was also installed, which is crucial for safe play for the nursery school children.

Multi-Use Games

Multi-Use Games Areas (MUGAs) are designed to incorporate a range of different sports requirements into one pitch using different turf and line markings. They are ideal for primary and secondary schools who are looking to make the most of limited space for a wide-range of sports on a limited budget.



MUGAs are great for multi-skills learning and allow pupils to practice a number of different sports within one lesson including:

Heathfield Knoll Independent Day School in Kidderminster was keen for a new MUGA to be installed at their facility. Bradleys used TigerTurf Evo Excel synthetic turf with a PVP shock pad for comfort and safety purposes. Markings were lined out for netball, tennis and football with all equipment from Hexa Sports and installed by the Bradleys in-house design team.



Longdon Hall School

The 600m² MUGA at Longdon Hall School in Staffordshire was a big project for Bradleys and involved constructing a fully engineered base and installing a Playrite 10mm shock pad and Playrite's MatchPlay 2 surface with lines for tennis and football. The surface is enclosed with a 3m high super rebound twin bar fence system with integrated football goals and basketball hoops.
