

Hauser & Wirth Installation

January 2019



It's the first time the team has ever installed the Fibonacci sequence as part of the artist, Matthew Day Jackson's design, who explores human interest and compulsion to document and map the natural world as a method for understanding it. The worked titled, 'Indoor Pitch' saw the gallery carpeted in synthetic turf with rectangles demarcated in white paint, suggestive of a sports field and bigger ideas around rules of engagement. The rectangles have been divided using the geometric ideal of the 'golden rectangle' – a principle Jackson revisits in his work.

The total area size was 184m² and we used TigerTurf EvoExcel for the surfacing of the sequence – a hard wearing, quality multi-sport product.

Broughton High School February 2019



The team headed up north to Preston at the beginning of February to refurbish an existing block of tarmac courts covering 1,837m². The first stage of the installation process involved drilling the base for drainage, jet-washing, then installing a Playrite 10mm shock pad and on top a MatchPlay 2 surface with inlaid lines for netball and tennis. Visually striking and a fantastic project to work on!



The Magic Garden Hampton Court Palace February 2019



In March, we were asked back by Hampton Court Palace near Richmond on Thames to carry out some refurbishment works on their Magic Garden play area, which covers a total size of $550m^2$. The process involved the uplift and removal of the existing surfacing and shock pad, the supply and installation of a Playrite 10mm shock pad and then TigerTurf Finesse Deluxe synthetic turf on top.



Cotham School

August 2019

In August, the team carried out the full construction of a 2,135m² rugby/football pitch in Bristol. The installation consisted of a fully engineered porous macadam base, subsoil drains system and 3m high B&L twin bar fence system. We also installed a 20mm insitu Nova Sport rubber shock pad and TigerTurf Rugby 360 surfacing – a quality rugby-specific innovative 3G surface, made using durable XWR yarn.

Old Hall & Seymour Road Academies

September & November 2019

In September and November respectively, we carried out two projects on behalf of DH Welton; Old Hall Academy and Seymour Road Academy in two different areas of Manchester.

Both projects were outdoor MUGA installations with TigerTurf Multi-Sport surfacing and in-laid lines for a variety of different sports.
